St. Mark's Episcopal church operates a unified Scouting Program via two Troops. Troop 211 (Boys) and Troop 1211 (Girls) serve youth between the ages of 11 and 17. Each troop is led by its own Scoutmaster, who work together with elected youth leaders from both Troops to deliver a single Scouting program. The Troops meet and participate in activities together and share resources (adult leadership, finances, camping equipment etc.).

On overnight campouts, boys and girls camp at the same campground and participate in activities together, while camping in separate campsites.

Troop Activities Include:



"The Windows" at Big Bend National Park, TX – January 2022

Summer Camp is a week-long residential camp experience and serves as a capstone experience for the program year. Troops 1/211 ordinarily travel to camps in mild climates (mountains or coast); Scouts earn merit badges, participate in fun activities and build team cohesion throughout the week.

High Adventure Treks: Scouts ages 14+ participate in various "high adventure treks" such as backpacking at Philmont Scout Ranch in Cimarron, NM and sailing at BSA Sea Base in the USVI.

Community Service: Opportunities to perform meaningful service include monthly gatherings to prepare lunches for the non-profit Kids' Meals as well as periodic scout-led "Eagle Projects", an annual Troop service project and more!

Weekly Meetings involve Scout-led skills instruction and games which are related to a monthly activity theme (climbing, shooting sports, canoeing, etc.)

Monthly Campouts allow Scouts to apply skills they learn at weekly meetings and are based on the same theme as the preceding weekly meetings.
